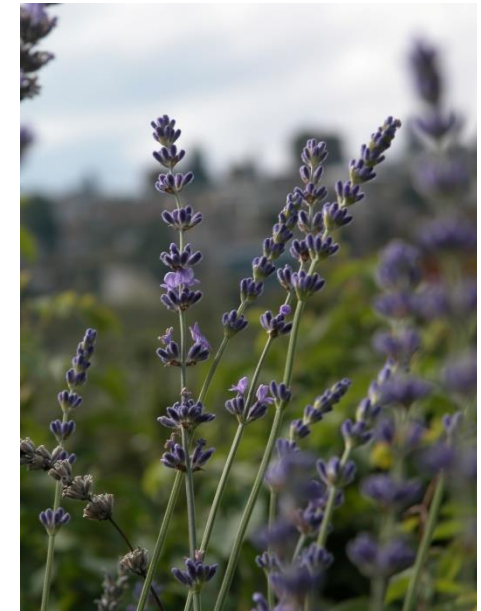

Cost

The cost for EACH module and exam is \$375, or \$350 for AHNA members and RJBA Alliances. Participants will be expected to pay for each module at the time it is offered. Additional associated costs will include *Clinical Aromatherapy: Essential Oils in Healthcare* (3rd edition) and required essential oils, which

vary in price from \$80 - \$150 per module. Please note that class size is limited.

Course Outline

This course is divided into 4 modules over 12 months. Each module is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. usually Saturday/Sunday. Packs of medicinal strength essential oils (from a selection of suppliers) must be purchased at each module.

Module 1 introduces the core concepts of clinical aromatherapy: evidence-based and research-backed.

Module 2 covers the use of essential oils for infection and stress control within a nursing/healthcare framework.

Module 3 outlines the chemistry of essential oils. Tutorial on student exam research project.

Module 4 covers women's health, chronic pain, cancer, and AIDS. Integration: policies and protocols. Exam prep. Second tutorial on exam research project

Certification Exam consists of two parts: written paper and presentation of project. The results are externally assessed. Successful completion of both parts is required for certification as a Certified Clinical Aromatherapy Practitioner (CCAP). Each participant must also complete 34 case studies. Exam fee: \$375.00. No discounts will be honored for the exam.
