Guidelines for content submission by members:

Great news, all active GOTA members are welcome to submit content. The GOTA YouTube Channel is a grassroots campaign putting members first by giving them a platform for engagement.

All content submitted to the Membership Committee for use on the GOTA YouTube Channel is property of the GOTA and maybe archived for future use. When you submit your content to GOTA you are consenting to GOTA distributing your information for current and future use.

Steps to submitting content:

1. Feel free to record content with your computer, phone, or through professional equipment. If using a phone please remember to hold the phone in horizontally (i.e. landscape mode). Recording vertically (i.e. in portrait mode) can be difficult to edit and view later.
2. Do not release information that is for proprietary use only such as videos from organizations for continuing education, assessments or tools requiring purchase, and/or any other materials requiring permissions from additional organizations for which prior approval has not been granted.

3. Ensure your materials are HIPAA compliant. Prior consent required for all individuals featured in video content. It is the sole responsibility of the individual submitting content to receive this consent.
4. Avoid profanity, vulgarity, and disparaging comments regarding specific individuals and organizations.
5. Provide:
 - a. Video title
 - b. Names of those in the video
 - c. Names of those who produced the video
 - d. Short description of the video
6. Indicate if the video should be shared as is or if edits are needed. If the video needs to be edited (shortened, sections deleted, or combined with other content) please provide information regarding your preferred edits.
