C.A.R.E Model of Practice for Pediatric Pharmacology and Occupational Therapy

C: Communicate with parents about any potential risks and emerging data.

A: Ask questions when you are not familiar with certain medications. Collaborate with your local pharmacist; therefore always ask.

R: Review medications with families to assist parents/caregivers with basic management.

E: Evaluate family capacity to manage medications, including side effects. Distinguish between effects of medications and occupational deficits.
